Remember that applications should be made directly by young people, only in rare situations will applications be received from adult leaders.

Talk with young people about the things they would like to achieve in sharing Jesus with their friends and community. Think about ways this might be done.

NOTE: Projects can continue beyond 31st December 2010 but you will need to show that you can take project to completion or next stage.

Are there people who you could work with to do this - other church youth groups or school Christian Union. As long as there is some Anglican involvement an application can be made.

When you feel ready, get the unique code off Dave and make your application on line at the YEF website (details available soon). You will be told how to send in any additional information you have prepared.

Applications must be made on line at the YEF website (details available soon). However, you can use the proforma application form to begin to shape your application. Also, look at other ways you can express what you want to achieve to the grant panel. Can you produce some artwork, a dvd or audio clip to support your application?

ALL GRANT MONEY WILL BE PAID OVER WITHIN approx a MONTH
A REPORT IS REQUIRED WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF COMPLETING THE PROJECT

After 15th May, if there is any of our allocation left it will be possible to put in application by 7th JULY. The risk is that all monies will be allocated in May, so please aim for May deadline.

Dave will be asked to comment on every application from this diocese. It will therefore be helpful to be in contact with him. The more he knows about your project the more specific his comments can be. The decision on grant funding is made by the YEF panel.
