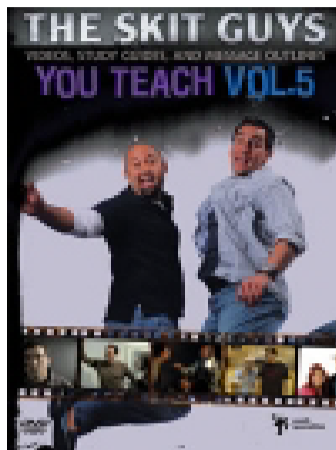
Bull's Eye Living with Stevie Stevenson

Approx 5 mins

A coach tries to get his student to hit the bull's-eye with a bow & arrow - some slapstick humour.

You Teach: The Main Point

Nobody hits the bull's-eye in every area of life all the time. We all miss the mark in some form or fashion—without exception. Whether it's the choices we make, the situations we find ourselves in, or the way we respond to circumstances, God has a bull's-eye on the target of life that we can (and should) shoot for each day.



Idol Worship

Approx 2 mins

Simple yet thought-provoking message - idol worship can be our attitude to football, a pop band or other area of our life.

You Teach: The Main Point

What if the idol worship that God warns us about has little to do with bowing before a stone or wooden image? What if it's more about evaluating our lives and the objects of our worship? After all, idol worship isn't merely something that happened in ancient days or in other cultures. Idol worship happens all around us, all day, every day, and in many different forms.

Sheep and Goats

Approx 2 mins

Two guys together - one 'the Christian', the other 'the world'. Unfortunately, 'the Christian' doesn't believe 'the world' has or can change.

You Teach: The Main Point

At some point in our lives we have to choose a side: with Jesus or apart from Jesus. Even Jesus says there will be a day when people—whom he compares to sheep and goats—will be separated and then headed to very different places for eternity. Because of who Jesus is and what Jesus has done to make a way for forgiveness and salvation, we can begin a new life, make a fresh start, and be found securely on Jesus' side today—and throughout eternity.

You Teach: The Main Point

Sometimes the most accurate way to describe how life feels is a tug of war.
